We enter April living in times of uncertainty and change. I have been thinking about two passages

of scripture and reflecting on the phrase "you are my witnesses".

The first passage comes in the book of Isaiah chapter 43 verses 10 to 12: "You are my witnesses,"

declares the Lord, "and my servant whom I have chosen, that you may know and believe me and

understand that I am ... God." This quote is part of a passage in which the prophet talks about God's faithful love for His people and the promise of salvation.

The second from the book of Acts chapter 1 verse 8: "... and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem, and in Judea and Samaria and to the end of the earth." These words were spoken by Jesus to the disciples after his resurrection and before he ascended into heaven.

There is something powerful about being a witness, about seeing something with our own eyes, hearing something with our own ears, or being present when something happens. There is something powerful about being able to tell others what you saw, or heard, or witnessed. For Christians our task as witnesses is linked to our duty to pray. In our Sunday Services week by week we pray for the world, for places where there is conflict. We pray that those people and places will experience the faithful love of God. We pray that they will experience the good news of Jesus.

Half-way through April this year we celebrate Easter. We would love to see you at all or any of our services that weekend.

On Good Friday we remember Jesus' torture and crucifixion, his death and burial. On Easter Sunday we remember and celebrate Jesus' resurrection from the dead. We remember that Jesus invited those who first witnessed his resurrection to tell the other disciples what they had seen and experienced. This is a task we share with them as we move from the Easter weekend into the Easter season. Not only will we be telling people about the resurrection of Jesus but we will be praying that salvation, resurrection light and life will be known by all people who feel as if they are completely stuck in the experiences of Good Friday.
