'Make a joyful noise to the Lord, all the earth! Come into his presence with singing!'

Whilst watching Glastonbury on the TV this year I came across the crowds singing some of comedian Jason Manford's 'Assembly Bangers'. In 2022, Jason recorded an album based on the songs that have been sung in school assemblies for decades, such as 'This Light Little of Mine', 'He's Got the Whole World in His Hands', 'When I Needed a Neighbour', 'Lord of the Dance', 'Shine Jesus Shine', 'One More Step Along the World I Go', and 'Sing Hosanna'. The single called 'Assembly Bangers' has been a huge success as the finale of Jason's live shows, with full arenas having a massive sing along. These 'bangers' are still staples for many weddings which take place in the churches across the Team each year.

Singing is good for you - it makes you feel better, enhances lung function, helps beat stress, improves memory, builds a sense of community, lets you express yourself, can help with pain relief, and boosts confidence.

I can personally relate to most, if not all, of those benefits, and see them in church, particularly the way singing builds a sense of community. The National Anthem on Remembrance Sunday is a good example of this. Each Sunday during our church services was sing three or four hymns/songs during worship, and you can feel the togetherness singing brings. This happens during weddings and funerals too. I had the privilege of conducting a funeral in church recently which included singing well known hymns as well as listening to tracks from The Smiths and Iron Maiden, just had the deceased had planned – thanks for the musical education, Jon, RIP!

Jesus himself would have sung during worship in the temple or when out with his friends. The 150 psalms which make up the Book of Psalms were like the hymn book of his day. They tell the story of peoples' lives and faith through the good, bad, and ugly of life. I invite you have a look at them and see if any resonate.

I also encourage you 'make a joyful noise' wherever you are and see how you feel. Whether it a traditional hymn, contemporary worship music, The Beatles, Take That, Alfie Boe, or Taylor Swift. Enjoy!
