#### 'A sharp intake of breath' by Revd Phil Rodd

Drawing breath during these coldest weeks of the year, it's tempting just to batten down the hatches, or if you must go out, to put on so many clothes that no one will recognise you - far less, will stop you for a chat in the street! At least January is over, surely the coldest – and longest – month of the year. I've always enjoyed this witty variant of the old rhyme about the months of the year: 'Thirty days hath September / April, June and November. / Unless a leap-year is its fate, / February hath twenty-eight. / All the rest have three days more, / excepting January, / which hath six thousand / one hundred and eighty-four.' Well, with winter dragging on, it can certainly seem like it! The Gospel readings this year are mainly from Luke – and should go some way to warm our hearts! February begins with 'Candlemas' – the Presentation of Christ in the Temple, when we encounter Jesus, the very same child who had been worshipped by the Wise Men in Matthew's Gospel now recognised by Simeon and Anna, who see him both as 'a light to lighten the Gentiles' and 'the glory of God's people Israel'.

In brief, it all points to Jesus as God's gift to the world - and to everyone in the world. And if he's for everyone, he's for us. And if he's for us, he's for each one of us, and for you too.

This year, Lent doesn't begin until March, with Ash Wednesday falling on 6th March – which leaves us with a whole month (albeit the shortest month of the year...) to focus on Luke's gospel and further revelations of who Jesus was, and what some of the strange but amazing things he did actually mean for us today. It's exciting stuff, and worth giving some thought to. Do keep an eye open for news of Ash Wednesday services, and of the course we'll be running during Lent – we'll be looking at the themes and characters in the musical, Les Misérables. In the meantime, every blessing for this, the shortest month!
