Lent – making it count!

How do we see Lent, I wonder. Just an opportunity to lose a few pounds that have stuck with us since Christmas? Or maybe to think about giving up some habit that someone's been nagging us about? Or maybe we've just given up thinking about it at all...

In the past Lent was taken more seriously, and Christians were expected to demonstrate this, not just negatively by giving up some of those 'little extras', but positively by engaging with programmes of prayer, study and fasting. It's only been in more recent times that Lent has been downgraded to giving up chocolate for a week – 'if I can manage it'.

Of course, the purpose of Lent has always been about following Jesus, who the Bible tells us started his ministry with a lengthy period of prayer and fasting, when he focused on his need to fulfil his Father's purposes, and to resist the temptation to give up when things got tough. So during Lent in all our churches we'll be hearing more about what it might mean for us also to fulfil God's purposes for us. We'll also be running midweek courses, open to everyone, to help us think through important aspects of Christian life. You'll find the details of these courses on the back page of this news letter.

Without doubt, though, the way to start Lent is by coming together where it all begins – Ash Wednesday, 18th February. There will be special services when we remind ourselves both of our own spiritual and moral frailty – which we do by the simple but beautiful rite of 'ashing' – and of our loving God who continues to walk with us no matter how frequently we mess up – which is partly what Communion is about, when we remember Jesus' sacrifice for us all in his death on the cross.

There are three services taking place on Ash Wednesday at different times across the day. Do get along to one if you can – it'll definitely help to make Lent count this year!
