**Minister's Message from Revd Jo**

“Holy smokes, Batman!” These are words which came out of my mouth when I saw the BBC News coverage of the white smoke billowing out of the chimney of the Sistene Chapel on the evening of 8<sup>th</sup> May signalling the election of the new Pope, Leo XIV. I was watching whilst preparing for my final engagement of the VE Day 80 celebrations that day, and what a lovely day it was too! The election of the new Pope, the 266<sup>th</sup> Pope since St. Peter, reminds me that the Church celebrates the feast of St Peter & St Paul on 29<sup>th</sup> June, which happens to be the day our curate-to-be, Hannah Morris, ordained deacon at Norwich Cathedral. Here’s a little bit about her

*‘I was born in Belgium and moved to England in 2010. My faith journey was profoundly shaped by the ecumenical community of Taizé in France, where I came to faith as a teenager and met my husband, Matt. Together, we have five daughters: Ella (16), Lotta (12), Arya (9), Clara (7), and Sterne, who is with us in spirit. The loss of Sterne during pregnancy has deeply shaped my sense of calling to the priesthood.*

Before this, I have a background in psychosocial work, supporting children, families, and young people in various settings in both Belgium and England. My faith inspires a passion for inclusivity, social justice, and creation care, which I’ve lived out through projects like Make Lunch and Messy Church. Outside of ministry, I love reading, baking, knitting, and exploring nature with our dog, Cosmo. I look forward to worshipping and serving Christ alongside you as part of the Flegg Group.’*

During Hannah’s time here I will be her Training Incumbent, so she will generally minister alongside me during her deacon’s year, but there’ll be plenty of opportunities to get to know her. While a curate’s role is often described as a time of learning and formation, it is also a time of mutual blessing. Hannah will bring fresh insights and gifts into the life of our Team, while we, in turn, can nurture and support her as she grows into her calling. **Jo**
