Minister's Message from Revd Jo

"Holy smokes, Batman!" These are words which came out of my mouth when I saw the BBC News coverage of the white smoke billowing out of the chimney of the Sistene Chapel on the evening of 8th May signalling the election of the new Pope, Leo XIV. I was watching whilst preparing for my final engagement of the VE Day 80 celebrations that day, and what a lovely day it was too! The election of the new Pope, the 266th Pope since St. Peter, reminds me that the Church celebrates the feast of St Peter & St Paul on 29th June, which happens to be the day our curate-to-be, Hannah Morris, ordained deacon at Norwich Cathedral. My faith journey was profoundly shaped by the ecumenical community of Taizé in France, where I came to faith as a teenager and met my husband, Matt. forward to worshipping and serving Christ alongside
you as part of the Flegg Group.'

During Hannah's time here I will be her Training Incumbent, so she will generally minister alongside me during her deacon's year, but there'll be plenty of opportunities to get to know her. While a curate's role is often described as a time of learning and formation, it is also a time of mutual blessing.
