A New Lens on Life by Revd Jo

I recently took my husband to his optician appointment as he couldn't drive after fracturing his ankle. He had been putting it off for months, and to 'encourage' him into going the branch for an appointment the company was going to stop his contact lenses from being despatched. As I was waiting for him in the waiting area I could hear a couple's conversation — the man was insisting his glasses were just fine despite his partner reminding him of increasing number of times he squinted at the newspaper or held his phone at arm's length. As I sat and listened, I thought about how easy it is to assume we see things clearly until, of course, we don't.

Thinking about eye tests - the calling out of letters that became sharper or blurrier with each lens adjustment - I realised how much this mirrored life itself. How often do we go through our days believing we have a full picture, only to discover we've been looking through the wrong prescription?

Scripture speaks often of seeing with new eyes. In 2 Corinthians 4:18, St. Paul reminds us, 'So we fix our eyes not on what is seen, but on what is unseen, since what is seen is temporary, but what is unseen is eternal.' How often do we focus on the small frustrations of the day: the unwashed dishes, the traffic jam, the careless word, while missing the deeper blessings God is revealing to us?

It's easy to get stuck in our perspective, assuming we know the whole story. That difficult colleague may be struggling with unseen burdens. The friend who hasn't called back might be dealing with personal struggles we can't fathom. Even in our own lives, the closed doors we lament may, in hindsight, be God's way of redirecting us to something different or even better.

This week, I'm making an effort to look at things differently to shift my focus from what's frustrating to what's meaningful, from the temporary to the eternal. Perhaps, like my husband's new lenses, a fresh perspective is all we need to see God's work more clearly.
