Minister's Message is from The Revd Richard Lamey, Diocesan Director of Mission and Ministry

I am about 8 months into my new job. Until July 2024 I was the Rector of a benefice of three churches in the market town of Wokingham and Area Dean of Sonning in Berkshire. I started work as the Director of Mission and Ministry in Norwich Diocese on the 1ST of September and have really not looked back since. I was a little anxious that I would miss the intensity and depth of parish life after 22 years but I have taken great comfort from the sense in which everything that I and the people I work with in the Parish Support Team do is about encouraging the local church in its mission and service. Three things have really stood out to me in my travels so far. One is the great beauty and long history of our churches and communities all across Norfolk and Waveney, how rooted and organic the church is in place, how naturally most of our churches sit in their location- both in terms of the physical building and in terms of the people who make up the church.

The second is how fortunate the Diocese and the local church are to have such a team of committed, generous and faithful people filling key roles which enables the local church to keep on keeping on. Faithfulness is an essential word in the way that individuals, many of whom have been in their role as Churchwarden or Verger or Treasurer for many decades, give so generously of their time and energy and life in order to make sure that the church building is still there as a place of encounter and holiness in the heart of their landscape. To everyone who is in that category of faithful service, thank you.

The third is how we help to put those faithful people and those rooted churches in the best position to share the love of Jesus with their community. We a consulting on a Diocesan Strategy at the moment which will be our strategy and a key question at the heart of it will be: What can the Bishops and Archdeacons and the Parish Support Team do or change in order to set the local church free to better be disciples and to have the confidence to invite others to be disciples of Jesus as well? We are rooted in our location- we have amazingly faithful people for which I give thanks- and together we need to explore how we better respond to the invitation of Jesus to be disciples in way which deepens and enriches our own life and also inspires others to find out more about who this Jesus is and why he is such Good News for the whole world and for every single person.
