Minister's Message

Do you remember the old hymn with the chorus: "Count your Blessings, name them one by one. Count your Blessings, see what God has done.

Count your Blessings, name them one by one, and it will surprise you what the Lord has done!"? We sang this recently at the Care Homes services I was leading in Martham and it was lovely to hear our older friends join in, some with great gusto, some very tunefully. As part of the services we were reflecting on childhood experiences of Church and Sunday School. Some people shared lovely memoires of favourite Bible stories, people from Church and special events at Church, including Church Anniversary celebrations. We prayed prayers of thankfulness for all these memories as well as for the things that happened in the past at Sunday School that we couldn't remember.

Our younger friends in Martham have been thinking about thankfulness too and I was invited to speak to the Brownies on this topic this month. Studies show that thankfulness and gratitude are increasingly important in maintaining good mental health and wellbeing. In some schools, children and young people are encouraged to keep gratitude journals or diaries to help them with the practice of looking for the positives in life with a thankful heart.

Thankfulness is such an important practice and discipline for us as followers of Jesus. Scripture encourages us again and again to be thankful. For example, 1 Thessalonians 5:18 give thanks in all circumstances and Psalm 107:8 give thanks to the Lord for his unfailing love. The ancient Christian discipline of thankfulness is the intentional, ongoing practice of giving thanks to God through conscious effort, recognising His blessings, and maintaining a grateful heart even in difficult circumstances. It is the practice of counting and naming our blessings each day.

I wonder whether practising thankfulness as an intentional discipline as the nights draw in winter is around the corner, will enable us to see God's blessings in unexpected places and encourage our hearts to be more aware of the love of God for us in the ordinary things of life.
