Minister's Message from Revd Debs

October is one of my favourite months and Harvest Thanksgiving is one of my favourite times in church. In Flegg Parish Churches Harvest has been marked in some of our churches in September and in others it will be celebrated in October. What a privilege to be able to gather to give thanks for the harvest, pray for our farmers and celebrate God's love not just in our churches but also in our local schools.
