But now it's September, which leaves many of us facing yet more highs and lows with the return to school for children and grandchildren – not to mention all who work in the 'field' of education.

How to respond to so many pulls on our attention? I'm reminded of the Prayer Course we ran earlier this year – a course which began with some great advice about prayer, to 'keep it simple, keep it real, keep it up'. Not to get carried away with complicated words or ideas in other words, but to be open to God about what's really on our hearts – and always to continue in prayer, and to trust the answers to our loving heavenly Father who knows all things, and who holds us all in the palm of his hands (Isaiah 41.10).

September (and October) also sees our harvest festivities in our Flegg Parish Churches. It's such an important time of year, as we consider again all the good things that God gives us – gifts to be received with gratitude, gifts to be enjoyed, and gifts to be shared. We also reflect on the miracle of food production, and pray for all whose hard work contributes in getting food from the field to the fork. How important for us to support those who work in farming, to encourage them, to buy food that's responsibly sourced and locally grown wherever possible – and to add our prayers into this mix!

Please do come to church this harvest time, and join in with the gladness, the thanksgiving and the sharing.
